DIRECTIONS TO CITY HALL:

From Interstate I-95 (from the North or from the South)

Take Exit 74C (A highway sign will say Library of Virginia). Proceed west on Broad Street until you reach 9th Street. City Hall is located at the corner of West Broad and 9th Street. You may enter the building from Broad, 9th or Marshall Streets. Please park in any legal parking space or city parking lot.

Interstate 64 West (e.g. coming from Williamsburg)

Take the exit for Fifth Street and the Coliseum. Turn left on Marshall Street a few blocks (past the Coliseum on your left) after you exit Interstate 64. Stay in the middle lane and proceed to Eighth Street, and turn right from that lane.

From Interstate 64 East (e.g. coming from Charlottesville)

Take Interstate 95 South to Exit 74C. See instructions above for I-95.

DIRECTIONS TO OPTIONAL PARKING (Car pooling is recommended):

I-95 North

Exit 74 C onto Broad Street. Public lot located between 11th and 10th Streets.

I-95 South

Exit 75 onto 3rd Street. Turn left onto Franklin Street. Turn left onto 7th Street. Public lot located on 7th Street between Franklin and Grace Streets.

I-64 East

Exit 75 onto 3rd Street. Turn left onto Franklin Street. Turn left onto 7th Street. Public lot located on 7th Street between Franklin and Grace Streets.

I-64 West

Exit 190 onto 5th Street. Turn left onto Franklin Street. Turn left onto 7th Street. Public lot located on 7th Street between Franklin and Grace Streets.

I-95 (RMA Downtown Expressway)

Exit 7th Street-9th Street. Turn left onto Franklin Street. Turn left onto 7th Street. Public lot located on 7th Street between Franklin and Grace Street.

DIRECTIONS TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY BUILDING

(The General Assembly Building is located at the corner of 9th and Broads Streets in downtown Richmond. Parking is not available in Capitol Square)
